UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

UNIFORM: GENERAL

- Your school uniform must be in a good state of repair and **worn correctly**.
- School blazers **compulsory** in term 2 and 3 and to **all functions requiring full school uniform**.
- A regulation Blue V-neck school jersey may be worn. School jersey for winter is long-sleeved and a sleeveless pullover for summer.
- Recipients of full colours / members of a first team sport or cultural activity may wear a white V-neck jersey.
- Plain navy blue or black scarves and gloves may be worn in winter.
- Recipients of full colours / members of a first team sport or cultural activity may wear a white scarf.
- Your school bag must not damage your schoolbooks.
- No rings or necklaces may be worn with your school uniform or on the sports field.
- No loose braids.
- Hair colour or highlights should be a natural colour e.g. blond, brown, black and ginger.
- No visible body piercing whatsoever.

BOYS' UNIFORM

GENERAL – APPEARANCE

- Hair must not touch eyes, ears, or collar. No outlandish styles.
- Braids longer than collar length, must be tied up.
- No earrings, studs or bristles in ears, lips, nose, or eyebrows.
- **CLEAN SHAVEN** with sideburns to mid-ear.

SUMMER

- Blazers optional in summer, if the regulation AGHS summer shirt with the **pocket badge** is worn. No tie is required with this shirt. (A short sleeve **WHITE** T-shirt may be worn under the shirt.)
- The sleeveless pullover can be worn in summer.
- Grey regulation trousers or shorts – **MUST** not to be frayed at the hems.
- A plain black/grey belt with an average size buckle is compulsory.
- Dark grey socks.
- Black, polishable shoes must be worn. **NO** ankle boots/ sports shoes are allowed.
- **NO HATS OR CAPS** are allowed **UNLESS it is AGHS**. (Can be obtained from Finance Office.)

WINTER

- School **blazers** compulsory in term 2 and 3 with **tie**
- A plain white regulation long sleeved shirt in winter **with tie** (-no visible vest or T-shirt to be worn under the winter shirt.)
- **Only official AGHS school caps and beanies may be worn with the school uniform. Can be purchased at school.**

GIRLS' UNIFORM

GENERAL

- Hair must not be in eyes; **long hair must be tied up at all times.**
- Only blue or white hair bands/clips may be worn.
- No make-up may be visible.
- Nails must be kept short. No nail polishes
- No jewellery to be worn.
- ONE pair of earrings, **either small studs or small sleepers**, may be worn at the bottom of the ear lobe.
- **BEADS in hair must be transparent clear beads only.**

SUMMER

- A plain regulation white open-necked short sleeved school shirt in summer, no visible vest or t-shirt underneath shirt.
- Blue school Pinafore, not more than 10cm above the knee when kneeling, no visible ski-pants.
- Blazers optional in summer. Sleeveless pullovers can be worn in summer.
- White school ankle socks in summer.
- Black polishable school shoes. (**NO** pumps or tommy's or sports shoes are acceptable)
- **Only official AGHS school caps and beanies may be worn with the school uniform. Can be purchased at school.**

WINTER

- School blazers compulsory in term 2 and 3 with tie
- A plain regulation white long sleeved school shirt with the school tie compulsory. (Terms 2 and 3)
- **Only official AGHS school caps and beanies may be worn with the school uniform. Can be purchased at school.**

NOTE: New Uniform Regulations. GIRL STYLED GREY TROUSERS MAY BE WORN IN TERM 2 AND 3 ONLY.

MATRIC PRIVILEGES
